TABLE 3 - Enrollment Projections by Grade

Enrollment projections are derived from live birth information from the school district, current enrollment, and affective trends such as migration into or out of the community. Projections are considered reasonably reliable for up to five years into the future. After that, the projection is somewhat speculative, and the figures less meaningful.

Data for the table below comes from the Buckland-Shelburne School and from the office of NESDEC, the New England School Development Council. Note that population trends indicate a gradual drop in enrollment for the next five years which accelerates after that. However, as already noted, the more distant projection should be viewed warily.
